Rules and Regulations

1. CURRENT NEGATIVE COGGINS test (taken within 12 months) must be presented to the Show Secretary before numbers will be issued. This pertains to all horses brought onto the show grounds, showing or not.
2. Release/waiver on entry form must be signed by parent/child before entry will be accepted. The signature for unrelated persons for minors will not be accepted.
3. Parent(s) or guardian(s) of minor exhibitors shall hold the Horse Show Management and Facility harmless for any injury to such minor.
4. Ages for Youth shall be as of January 1, 2009 and are under age 18. Proof of age should be available should it be called into question.
5. The Judges decisions are final.
6. The SC Festival of Flowers Horse Show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry, add, combine, cancel, change or split classes or to change show officials.
7. No horses, vehicles or persons are permitted in barns, yard or beyond posted areas.
8. ALL DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH.
9. There will be NO refunds.
10. Any person who is abusive to any animal or person will be asked to leave.
11. NO youth showing or handling of stallions.
12. Proper show attire required.
13. Unlicensed drivers are not permitted to operate any motorized vehicles, ATV's, motorcycles, golf carts, etc. on the show grounds.
14. No alcohol.

Stall and Camper Hookup Information

Stalls will be 10 x 10 panel stalls under our 100 x 100 covered arena. Stalls are \$20 each for a 1 night stay or \$30 for a 2 night stay. We will supply shavings with additional bags for sale for \$5.00 each during the show. Each stall is to be CLEANED before leaving. . **Stalls and Camper hookup must be reserved and paid in full by May 15, 2009 (non-refundable).**
